Heron (Ardea cinerea) Rode Pool 23 nests; Doddington Pool 1 nest.

Mute Swan (Cygnus olor)

Winterley Pool pr. bred with 4 young; Fields Farm Flash pr. bred with 2 young; Alsager Mere pr. bred with 5 young.

Bewick's Swan (Cygnus columbianus) At PHF 17 March to 23 April.

Pink-footed Goose (Anser brachyrhynchus) Occasional singles.

Ruddy Shelduck (Tadorna ferruginea)

Ad. at EHF from 27 to 30 June and the same bird at Doddington Pool on 16 December.

Mandarin (Aix galericulata)

Sightings throughout the year but no proved breeding from the previously used sites.

Gadwall (Anas strepera)
1 m. at PHF 20 October. 1 Ad. at Arclid SQ from 27 August to 2 September.

<u>Garganey</u> Anas querquedula)

1 f. and 1 juv. at EHF from 17 to 29 July.

Goldeneye (Bucephela clangula)

On 16 December 2 m. at PHF and 1 m. + 2 f. at Doddington Pool during freezing weather, where also 1 m. on 27th January and 2 f. on 24 December.

Goosander
1 f. at EHF on 3 February.

Ruddy Duck (Oxyura jamaicensis)

Regular sightings but no proved breeding. Numbers seemed to be down.

Buzzard (Buteo buteo)

At last, confirmed sightings in the Crewe Hall and surrounding areas. At least 1 bird probably resident.

Merlin (Falco columbarius) 1 f. at WLF on 18 April.

Hobby (Falco subbuteo) 1 ad. at EHF on 20 July.

(Falco peregrinus)

First returned to RF on 12 August and present throughout the winter.

(Coturnix coturnix)

3 single records in early June from Burleydam near Audlem, South of Alsager, Smallwood.

- <u>Little ringed plover</u> (Charadrius dubius)

 Breeding pairs at EHF, Rookery Bridge, Sandbach,
 Taylor Burgess Elworth, Arclid SQ (3 4 pairs) Bent Farm
 Astbury.
- Grey Plover (Pluvialis squatarola)

 1 over EHF on 5 October.
- Little stint (Calidris minuta)

 1 or 2 at EHF September/October and 10 November.
- Curlew sandpiper (Calidris ferruginea)
 Singles at EHF from 25 August to 3 October.
- Marsh sandpiper (Tringa stagnatilis)
 1 at PHF on 20 May.
- Black-tailed Godwit (Limosa limosa)
 2 records from PHF with 7 on 1 August and 1 on 10 August.
- Whimbrel (Numenius phaeopus)
 Singles at EHF, PHF, Arclid SQ, in early autumn.
- Spotted redshank (Tringa erythropus)
 Singles at PHF, RF in March and April.
- Black tern (Chlidonias niger)
 An exceptional nationwide passage on 2 May was represented locally with 33 at WLF, 12 at Arclid SQ and 26 at Hurleston Reservoir. Also 1 at Arclid on 13 May.
- Stock Dove (Columba oenas)
 6 prs. in nest boxes at Quaker's Coppice.
- Turtle dove (Streptopelia turtur)
 1 ad. at Arclid SQ on 9 June.
- Barn Owl (Tyto alba)

 Prs. bred at Crewe Hall, Congleton Town Centre, near Bunbury and together with other sightings represent an encouraging increase.
- Short-eared owl (Asio flammeus)
 2 near PHF on 11 February.

Grey waqtail (Motacilla cinera)

The winter roost formed again at Arclid SQ but reduced in numbers.

Redstart (Phoenicurus phoenicurus)
Singing m. in mid-June at Roe Park near Mow Cop
and west side of The Cloud, Congleton. Also an ad. at
Arclid SQ on 25 April and a juv. at Barthomley on
16 July.

Wheatear (Oenanthe oenanthe)

Low numbers EHF/PHF on passage. Also singles at Arclid SQ and near Mow Cop.

Grasshopper warbler (Locustella naevia)
 1 m. "reeling" in late May near Barthomley.

Wood warbler (Phylloscopus sibilatrix)
Singing m. in mid-June at Roe Park near Mow Cop
and west side of The Cloud, Congleton. Also at
Brereton Country Park on 7 May,

Blue tit (Parus caeruleus)
6 prs. used nest boxes at Quaker's Coppice.

Great tit (Parus major)
1 pr. used a nest box at Quaker's Coppice.

Nuthatch (Sitta europaea)

1 pr. used a nest box at Quaker's Coppice for the first time and fledged 5 juvs.

Lapland bunting (Calcarius lapponicus)

1 reported from Sandbach Flashes but no details.

Common Sandpiper (Actitus hypoleucos)

I pr. bred at Arclid s.Q., the first proved breeding there.

Reed warbler (Acrocephalus scirpaceus)

2 m. singing during the summer from the maturing marsh at EHF were the first recorded there.
