SECOS Winter Garden Bird Survey - 1988/89

The 4th Winter Garden Bird Survey was carried out from October 1988 to april 1989. Nineteen members participated, but unfortunately three did not return records for the second half of the survey.

The survey produced no exceptional results this year, caused no doubt by the mild weather. It was the mildest winter recorded since 1869 and the second mildest since 1669 for the period December 1988 to February 1989.

I attach a summary of the species recorded and as an index I have used 'garden / weeks'. This refers to the number of weeks in which a species is recorded in all gardens, regardless of numbers and is used to assess how common a species is. Also given is the number of gardens in which any species was recorded and the maximum number seen in any one garden.

A total of 51 species was recorded, two more than last year.

I enclose recording sheets for the coming winter in anticipation of your continued support.
